


Transcription of Rev Leckie's Diary – 1718

Book Two

1 October 1718 - 23 November 1718



Transcribed from the original secretary script
by Ruth Murray, Camus Cottage, Ross Priory and later Drumgannoch in 1960s

Oct. 1 Wed. 1718. This morning I read some on
V.1 of Rom. Hist. & wrote my sermon preach'd July 27
before noon, then I went forth to see Captain
Buchanan (brother to Spittal elder) & Lady who
now did live in Spittal with Spittal younger.

In my way thither I went by Hillhead of
Mid Cattas & received my money from Jo.
⁴³ Mitchell lent on Saturday last & then I
went to Cattermill where I did not a discourse
some dyne. From thence I went to Spittal where
I discoursed some dyne with Spittal elder &
wife & then went in to their other house
& saw Captain Buchanan & Lady & having
discoursed some dyne with them they came in
Craigieon, younger & Wm. Govan of Buckapple
& then I left them & came to Mid Cattas
where I found my wife. Here I did eat &
drink some. We came home about 7 & after
supper & worship went to bed about 10 & read
on V.1 of Rom. Hist.

Oct. 2 Th. This day being stormy with wind & rain I kept at home all day & I wrote up all my sermons preacht on 2 Tim. 1-9 After supper & worship went to bed at 10 & read on V. 1 of Rom. Hist. o V. 1. of Bapt. Life.

Oct. 3 Frid. This day being like the former I kept at home all day & read on the foresaid books & wrote my sermons preacht on Sept. 21 & 28 before noon. After supper & worship went to bed at 12

Oct. 4 Sat. This morning I read some on V. 1 of Bapt's. Life & then prepared for the ensuing day. This night Marion McAlister darryed with me. After supper & worship went to bed after 12.

Oct. 5 Sun. This morning I endeavoured to prepare for the work of the day. I went to Church at half 12 & lectured on Rev. 3-7 & preacht a Do. 16-8 & again on Math. 25-19 without dismissing the people & had much of divine assistance. After sermon my father in law came into my house & did rest a little. After which I did

read on Tues. on Rev. I aupt at 6 & then what about worship & was long herein & then catechized my family. I went to my room & read on V. 13 of Tilletson's Sermons & went to bed at 10 Oct. 6 Morn. This day I designed to have gone to Glasgow to attend the Synod there but the day being so rainy there was no stirring out of a door. I kept at home all day & finished V. 13 of Tilletson's Sermons & read some on Bapt. Life V. 1 & then prepared against the next Lord's Day. After supper & worship went to bed about 12 & read on the foysaid book.

Oct. 7 Tues. This morning I mounted my horse to go to Glasgow & Thos. Leckie behind me. I arrived there at 1 o'clock & went straight to my quater viz. Stephen Crawford's. Here I dined. After dinner Mr. Arch. Hamilton, minister of Cambuslang came in & discoursed with my brother in law & told us Mr. Jo. Currie, minister of Monkland was chosen Moderator to the Synod. After which

I did attend the synod. The Minutes this night were read through. After which I went this night to Mrs. Kirkwood who told me her daughter was to be married on Thursday. After sitting here above one hour I went to my quarters & after worship went to bed after 11.

Oct. 8 Wed. This morning I went forth to wait on Shawfield about 9 o'clock with whom I discourse a little about the paroch of Rosehaugh who invited me to dine with him. From there I went to the synod. This day I did depose Mr. Ja. Stewart who was formerly suspended from the Ministry. About 2 o'clock I dined with Shawfield & his Lady. There were at dinner one Mr. Stewart a son of Culterhouse & Mr. To. Grant, minister of Affleck. After dinner I did attend the synod who had nothing very material before them. At night we mett in Ply. to confer on the Oath of Abjuration but did nothing. After

which I went to my quarters & after supper -
worship went to bed about 11 o' clock on a
Pamphlet entitled "Mr. Taylor's Case Stated."

Oct. 9th. This morning I arose pretty early
& went to Mrs. Kirkwood & married her
daughter to Ja. Wylie, from her I went to
Church & heard Mr. Walt. Kenyons preach on
1 Jo. 3:16 I was refreshed, they brother in law
having a child baptized & called Robert.
Mr. Kenyons & I went to the banquet after
which we did attend the synod. This
evening they went through all the business
& arose about 2 o'clock. From here I went
to Mr. Anderson & dined. There were here
present Mr. Rob. Johnston, Mr. Will. Love.
Mr. Rob. Lee Jordan & Mr. Ja. Semple. After
⁴⁵that I went to Mrs. Kirkwoods & her friends
met & we had a marriage feast. There
was here at the feast Ja. Peachie of
Rough Hill, Ja. Duke of Clayborn, Baylie Brown

Mr. Jo. Stewart & wife & son, Alexr. Rowand
& wife, Baylie Ritchie, Rob. Wyllie, Jo. Wyllie
& family, & some other young women. This day
I had a violent colick in my stomach
which was very sore upon me towards night.
I came home about 11 & being much pained
in my stomach I sat up till one & then
went to bed.

Oct. 10 Frid. This morning I went to Thistlefield
& discouert him some considerable dyne
about the affair of Rosemarkie. Mr. Jo. Grant
came in upon us. After I had left him
I went to Rob. Crawford's shop & discouert
some dyne with his wife & then mett with
Richard Scadlock & provided my self in
new loose furniture & drank some with him.
I walkt a little about the Crosse & then
went to Mr. Jo. Sterling's & dined with him
& prayd. After dinner I mett with Pat.
Walker & Mr. McFarlane & Will. Thomson

or drank with them. Then Mr. Mc farlane & I walked in the Green a little. After that I sat a little in Mrs. Kirkwood's & then in my uncle Jo. Brodie's & then went to Rob. Scott's & suppt where were present my brother in law, Baylie Crawford & wife, Da. Maxwell & wife, Rob. Crawford's wife & my brother Will. We came home again at 10. After worship went to bed after 11.

Oct. 11 Sat. This day I was firmly resolved to go home & put by some of my affairs for this end & made myself ready but at 11 o'clock there came on a violent rain so that there was no going over a door. Mr. Mc farlane being to go with me he inclined to tarry & I was detained by Hugh Crawford & my sister. The rain continued all day. Toward night I went & saw Mrs. Campbell, relict of Mr. Duncan Campbell. Here I did rest & talk some time with her & Mr. David Munro who was in her house & from thence I went to the Buchanans

& here I did rest some time & then came to
my quarters where I found Mr. McFarlane. He
was slept, he did stay till after after 9 o'clock
& then went home. After supper & worship went
to my room & read on Mr. Taylor's Case stated
& went to my bed after 11.

Oct. 12 Sab. Being prepared for my publick work
I arose after 5⁻ to ride home. I put on my coat,
caused saddle my horse & at 6 came on a
great shower of rain & fearing it would
continue so through the day I caused put
up my horse again & resolved to abide in
the place. After breakfast & worship I went
to the Laigh Church & heard Mr. D. Anderson
lecture on Acts 2:27- close & Mr. Ja. Clark
preach before noon on Oct 4 & 5⁻ o afternoon
Mr. Anderson on Math. 18:26 & was refreshed.
After sermon I went to David Pagan's wife's
suriall & after I returned to my quarters
I read a V. & of Pool & went about worship.

A little before supper Rob. Crawford my nephew, came in to his father's, who had been at London & came from Leamington that morning. He had no news. We slept after 6 after which several neighbours gathering in to the house I lectured on 2 Tim. 3: 1-6 & was assisted & having discourse a little went to my room & read on 1.2 of Pool & went to bed about 11.

Oct. 13 Tues. This day after worship & sharing I went forth & met Mr. McCafflane. We went soon to Rob. Scott's & rested a little & then to Will. Dow's & rested some time & here I was invited to dine. Before dinner I went to Rob. Smith's & did rest some time & then dined with Will Dow & did rest a long time with him & borrowed 4 volumes of the Athenian Oracle. After which I met with Mr. McCafflane & did walk to the bridge. After which we met with Pat. Walker & drank with him & then I went to my sister Rebecca's & did rest in her house

untill it was pretty late. After supper & worship
went to bed after 11.

Oct. 14 Tues This day Mr. McFarlane & I resolved
to go home together & made ready for our
journey. Before I went off I bought a new
calico gown to my wife from Rob. Crawford
as also a valise from Rich. Scadlock to
put my cloaths in which kept me long
in town untill it was ready. Mr. McFarlane
& I went off near to 1 o'clock. We rode
together to Rams o'dind. Here I mett with
my brother in law, Jo. Buchanan & then we
called at Belvoir but the Lady was not
at home. We rode together to Catter Bridge
& here we parked. I came home against 7
& found my family all well (Blessed be God)
& did chaff with them till near 10. After
supper & worship went to bed.

Oct. 15 Wed This morning I read some on
V. 1 of the Athenian Oracle & being called I went

to see Will Garner in Kains & saw him
dying. With him I conversed & prayd thrice
untill he breathed his last. I think he dyed
a good man, belovd by all that knew him.

As I was coming away to McKinlay in K.
Baturich entreated me to baptize a child
to him to morrow the which I consented to do.

My wife being with me we went from this to
Dr. Kegoun's & did rest some by me & eat &
drink & then we called at Downie & then re-
walt to Red Cather & tarried but a little
my father in law not being at home. We
came home by Dr. Leckie's & did rest some
by me with Dr. Miller in Dumbarton. After
we came home, which was after 7, I read
some on V.1 of Athenian Oracle & after supper
& worship went to bed near to 12 & read on
the foorsaid book.

Oct. 16 Th. This morning I read some on
'Mr. Taylor's Case Stated' & then rode to

M. Baturich & baptized Jo. McKinlay's child
who was called Marion. I lectured on
Ps. 16. 1-4 Then were present Wm. McEchrie
⁽⁴⁸⁾ Pat. McKinlay, & Grizall Connell & son,
John Buchanan at Hill of Bellough. I
returned by High Knockour & saw blind
Lath. Garner. With her I conversed & prayed.
I called at Will. Govan's, Jo. Mcaulay's. &
Arch. Govan's & at Rosse but Drumakill
& Lady were not at home. I came home
near to 7 & read on V. 1 of Athenian Oracle.
After supper & worship went to bed near 12
& read on the foreaid book.

Oct. 17 Frid. This morning I caused kill a cow
I had grazing with Jo. Mathie in Isent. As
I was at breakfast Mr. Parlane came & took
a share. After which we went both to Wm.
Garners burial in Hains. Here I was
informed that Eliz. Craig, daughter to
Mr. Ja. Craig, had brought forth a child

in fornication to one Andrew Millar, her
father's servant. It was never known she was
with child untill she was travelling (travailing)
She was of good repute & about 44 years of
age. After the buriall Arch. Govan dined
with me. At night I read an V. 1 of the
Athenian Oracle. After supper & worship went
to bed after 11

Oct. 18 Sat. This forenoon I enquired into my
worldly state what I was owing & what was
owing to me. After mid day I walkt to the
Mains & saw Wm. Gomers relict & discount
some byme with her & son. As I returned I
mett with my father in law & Dr. Mitchell
my late servant who walkt home with me
& dined & then prepared for the work of the
following day. At night I caused salt
the cow I killed yesterday. After supper
& worship went to bed after 12

Oct. 19 Sab. This morning I endeavoured to

prepare for the work of the day. I went to church
about half 12 & lectured on Rev. 3. 7-12 & preach
on Jo. 16, 8 & again on Mat. 25:19 & had much
of divine assistance. After sermon my mother &
sister in law did rest some time in my house
& the night being pleasant did walk some
⁴⁹ in my yard. I slept about 6 after which I went
about worship & was long herein & then
catechized my family & went to my room &
read on Dush. on Rev. I went to bed about 10.
Oct. 20 Tues. This day I kept at home all day
& wrote up all my sermons on Jo. 16. 8. Wm.
Garnett's relief Anne McEchie dined with me.
At night I read some on V. 1 of the Atheneum
Oracle & after supper & worship went to bed after 11
& read on the foresaid book.

Oct. 21 Tues. This morning I wrote up my sermon
preacht Sep. 14 afternoon & saw some loading
beats to me & then went to visit family
according to my Intimation & did visit

Druenglass, Nevis, M. Fintornie & Duncrein
came home at 6 & dined. Then was with me
Will. Garner in Kains to whom I lent 18 lbs. Scots
at night read some on V. 1 of the Athenian Oracle.
After supper & worship went to bed about 12.

Oct. 22 Wed. This morning I took my afternoon's
sermon preacht Sept. 21 & then went to visit
familys & did visit Lamsmoun, Blarlock,
Shingles. As I came home I saw Ja. Bryce,
younger, weaver, with whom I discouert & prayd.
As also Ja. Bilsland, younger, in Gartocharn
with whom I discouert & prayd. I came home
near to 7 & dined & did chat with my family.
After supper & worship went to bed near to 12
& read on V. 1 of Athen. Oracle.

Oct. 23 Th. This morning I went forth to visit
family & did visit Coldarvane, Blarnisle,
Tullichen, I came home after 8 a clock
& slept. This night I feed my servant for
5 lbs. Scots & a peck of meal or half a merk

After worship which was after 10 I went to bed & read some on V.1 of Athenian Oracle.

Oct. 24 Frid. This morning I wrote my sermons preach on Sept. 28 & then went forth to visit families & did visit Lednishmore, Baturich, & Knockour. I came home near to 10 & after supper & worship went to bed about 12 & read some on V.1 of Athenian Oracle.

⁵⁰ Oct. 25. Sat. This day I was at home & prepared for the following day & saw Geo. Mitchell finish the thatching my house. About 4 o'clock Doctor Campbell & my father in law came & discoursed with me. After supper & worship I went to bed near to 1.

Oct. 26 Sd. This morning I endeavoured to prepare for the work of the day. As I was going to the Church, which was near to 12, Doctor Campbell, Craigton & my brother in law did alright at my house. I lectured on Rev. 3. 12-18 & preach but once on Matt. 25-19 & had

much of divine assistance. After sermon the Doctor & Gentleman came into my house & sat a little. Craigton went to Rosse & the rest with my father in law slept with me & sat till near 8 after which I went about worship & was long herein & then catechized my family & went to my room & read some on Bush. on Rev. & went to bed near to 12.

Oct. 27 Tues. This morning I wrote some of my notes preach'd on Oct. 5 for noon. After which the session met & did distribute some money for the poor. I was informed on Saturday last that my father in law had 6 cows stolen out of Gartshoran which had been grazing with Jo. Dougall. After dinner & reading some on the Athenian Oracle I walked to Jo. Mc. gowen's & discours'd with him till after 9 & after supper & worship went to bed near to 12.

Oct. 28 Wed. This morning I went & saw Wm. Bryce with whom I convers'd & pray'd & then according

to appointment did visit Ardoch, Portnellans.
I bought a cow from Arch. Govane for 17 lbs. I
went to Rosse against night & did chat to
Drumakill & Lady. I found them both in
great wrath at Lady Balire & my brother in law
for an extravagant count given in to them.

After supper & worship I did visit the family
& pray with them. I went to bed about 12 &
read some on Cornelius Pape? in English.

5th Oct. 29 Wed. This morning I did chat with
Mr. Parlance & after breakfast near to 12 I went
to visit the Ciber & went through the same
against 8 a clock & then rode home & slept.
Drumakill & Lady rode to Killpatrick this day
to see friends. I went to bed being weary about 11.

Oct. 30 Th. This morning I wrote up my sermon
preach Oct. 5 & 12 afternoon & then I with my wife
did walk to Mid Caffar where we did not &
~~not~~ chat some hours. We heard no news.
My father in law had no account of his

6 cows stolen from him the last week. We
came home about night falling. I did chat
some in Walt. Galloway's house. After supper
& worship went to my room & wrote a letter
to Cozy. Leckie craving money. I went to bed at 12.
Oct. 31 Frid. This morning I read some on V. 1
of Athenean Oracle in my bed. After I arose
I wrote up my sermon preacht on Sabbath last
& being sent for I rode to see Wm. Bryce with
whom I discouerst a long byme & prayd. Here
I mett with Mr. Parlane. After I came home
I dined & then read on V. 1 of Athenean Oracle. After
supper & worship went to bed after 11.

Nov. 1 Sat. 1718 This morning I began to write
my sermon preacht Ouly 12 Sat. at Cardross
Communion. At breakfast Mr. Bryce, shoemaker
in Glasgow informd me there was a
rabble in Gorbells of Glasgow about stolen
brandy & that the soldiers being call'd did
fire on the rabble & kill'd one man, a skinner

who was standing by. While I was at dinner Mr. Parlane (who was to preach to-morrow) came to me & took a share. After which he & I discoursed till supper & after this & worship went to my room & read an Disc. on Rev. I went to bed about 12.

Nov. 2 Sat. This morning I endeavoured to prepare my lecture. I went to Church near to 12 & lectured on Rev. 3, 17 - close. Mr. Parlane preacht after me on Acts 3, 1st. We were both very well assisted of God. After sermon my father & sister in law sat some time. Mr. Parlane stayd not to sup but went to Rosse. I suppt about 5 & then went about worship & was long herein & then catechized my family. After which I went to my room & wrote some. I went to bed after 11.

Nov. 3 Sun. This day I kept at home all day & wrote up my sermon preacht ⁵⁻² July 13 on Jo. 6: 35 At night did chalk some in Hill. Galloways

I read some on V. I. of Athen Oracle. I went to bed after 11 a clock.

Nov. 4 Tues. This morning I went off to the Pby. & put a shoe on my horse at Bent & saw Jo. Bilsland & Wm. Bryce in my way thither. & with them I discoursed & prayd. When I came thence I heard Mr. Diveres have a Presbyteriall - - in the Church on Luke 16. 31 which was approven. Mr. Logan was chosen Moderator. This day two Elders from Lissie desired a Minister to moderate in a call to Mr. Jo. Mc Laurin, the which was granted. As also the Magistrates & Session of Dumbarton desired the same favour with reference to the foresaid person the which was refused, upon which there was one appeal to the next Synod as also two from Rosemarkie desired a Minister to moderate in a call the which was granted. These things took up long time One Doctor Hamilton in Dumbarton was

pursued by the Pby. for some blasphemous
speeches against the son of God & speaking
lightly of the Holy Sacraents, the last he
confest but denyd the first. Sentence delayd
to another day. We dined about 9 a clock
& then discouert till after 2. In my way to
Dumbarton I was informed that Alexr. Graham
in Mavis of Buchanan had brought from
Wm. Buchanan of Ardoch the Town of
Coldarwan. This night I lay with Mr. Logan.
Nov. 5th Lled. This morning I went forth & saw
Wm. Graham & wife & converst some tyme
with them & one Wm. Barnes, shoemaker, & then
went & saw Mr. Jo. Mc Laurin & then went & saw
⁵³ Mr. Arch. Wallace. I mounted my horse about,
& called at Levensyde where Mr. Anderson & I
discouert Lady Grizall aent our schoolmaster's
salary who promist to wryte to Edinburgh
to Messan[?] aent the same. In my way home
I was desir'd to go & see tho. Buchanan

soon to Walt. in Skineggs, accordingly I went
& discouerst some hymn & prayd. I likewise
call'd & saw Wm. Bryce & discouerst with him &
prayd. At Aibert I mett with brother in law
going to the Rosse where I talkt a little with
him. I came home after sunset. A little hymn &
after Mr. Dorrimer our present probatorie &
Jo. Mcgour came & sat some hymn with me.
I made them to eat & drink; having busness
with Jo. Mcgour he ent to Jo. Mcgour's all
night. After supper & worship ent to bed about 11.
Nov. 6th. This morning Pat. Mcalpine came &
gave me 12 sh. 14 st. Scots & then I went to
Court of Kilmarnock at muirrie. Here I
got complek payment from Jo. Mc Kinlay
in Bellough for 1717. David Colquhoun was
Baillie. I heard several claims given in
before him at the time. One Donald
Buchanan, a minor, did choose his curators
viz. my father in law & brother in law,

& Jo. Buchanan of Blairquhan. After which we
dined, there were many present viz. Spittal, elder,
Baylie Colquhoun & Clark Cameron, my
father & brother in law, Pat. Strachan. Arch. Govan
& I came home about 8. A little after my
father & brother in law came & stayd till after 10.
After they had gone home & worship went to bed about 12
Nov. 7 This morning I caused kill the cow I
got from Arch. Govan after which as I was
going forth to visit according to appointment
I was informed by my late servant Kath.
Mc farlane that the Mistress of the Spittal had
dyed this morning about 5 a clock upon which
I did alter my resolution & thought it most
convenient to go to Spittal. Accordingly
I went & in my way call'd at Mid Catto
^{5th} where I did rest with father & brother in law. When
I came to Spittal I dis count long with Captain
Buchanan & some other company in the room
& then went & saw Spittal, elder, who was in

another room. With him I discouert a considerable
lyme. I came home again by Mid Cattar where
I did not a little. Then I came home I did chaff
with my family & Dr. Mitchell my late servant.
After supper & worship I went to bed about 12
Nov. 8 Sat. This day I endeavoured to prepare for
the work of the following day. Wm. Garner in
Rains payd 30 sh. ster. he had borrowed from me
as also Mr. McFarlane payd me some money
he had borrowed. Wm. Buchanan, son to
Cathermiller did rest a long lyme & dine with
me, at which lyme the Ladys Drumakill,
elder & younger came & sat some lyme in
my house having come from the Spittall.
At night I caused cut & salt the cow I
killed yesterday. After supper & worship went to
bed after 12.

Nov. 9 Sab. This morning I endeavoured to
prepare for the work of the day. I went to Church
near to 12 & lectured on Rev. 4. 1-7 & preacht

a Math. 25. 19 & had divine assistance. After sermon my father in law came into my house & rest some tyme & told me that the soldiers that had lain in Drymen, of Sharpe's regiment this long tyme had marcht to Glasgow early this morning & that those in Inverness were to march to morrow. I aupt after 5 after which I went about worship & was long herein & then catechized my family & then went to my room & read an Dush. on Rev. I went to bed after 10.

Nov. 10 Mon. This morning I wroke up some of my sermons preacht yesterday & then my wife & I rode to Spittall's wife's buriall. There were at it all the Gentlemen on the water. She was interred at Buchanan. Here Cosy Leckie payd me 20 sh. ster. he was owing me more than 6 years by gone. I came home by the boat of Colombe & sent my horse for my wife. At night I read some on V. of Athen.

Crack. At night Dr. Leckie sent me a guinea
he had borrowed from me about 14 days ago.
After supper & worship went to bed after 11.
Nov. 11 Tues. This morning I sent my servant
to Glasgow with 205 mecks I was owing to
Helen Craig. This is the last of my debt except
some very small counts. It was proven by
witnesses that Marion Howat, servant to Jo.
Garnett in Balfouring was found in naked
bed with him. After which we dined in Mr.
Anderson's rig. Mr. Park, Mr. Mcfarlane, & I. I
rode home after 6. It was one of the darkest
nights that ever I saw, my horse led me home.
At night read some on V. I. of Athen. Crack.
After supper & worship went to bed about 12.
Nov. 12 Wed. This morning (being calld) I rode to
Shinegill & saw Walt. Buckanans child who
was lying with a feaver with whom I
conversed & prayd. After I came home I
designd to visit familys but the day being

so rainy I could not go forth. I caused
winnow a boll of bear & wrote up all my
sermon preach Sabbath last & also part of
that preach at Dumbarton Aug. 9 on 1803. 2.19
At night read on V.1 of Athen. Oracle. After
supper & worship went to bed after 11.
Nov. 13 Th. This day according to appointment
I went forth to visit familys & did visit
Kirkhouse, Badshellock, Ibort & almost the
West Cattar. I came home near to 6 & dined.
My servant delivered me a letter from
Baylie Crawford bearing the payment of the
money I sent to Glasgow & also sent me the
bond. I had no news very remarkable.
Rob. Crawford had a son baptized about 14
days ago called Hugh. I read some on V.1.
of Athen. Oracle. After supper & worship went to bed
about 12.
Nov. 14 Frid. I went forth this day to visit
familys & did visit the remaining part of

East Calker. I was conveyed near home by
56 Barth. Miller, weaver. After dinner I woke up
my sermon on Hos. 2.19 & read on V.1 of A. K. Or.
After supper & worship went to bed after 12.
Nov. 15 Sat. This morning I wrote a part of my sermon
on Song 1.4 & then prepared for the following day
& woke up the same in my book. At night
I did talk some with Ja. Garner, weaver.

To. Mc Kinlay in Aiber was socht? with
Magt. Mc farlane & Ja. Garner there come with
him. After supper & worship went to bed after 12.
Nov. 16 Sab. This morning I prepared for the work
of the day. I went to Church near to 12, lectured
on Rev. 4.6 - close & preach on Math. 25.19 & had
divine assistance. After sermon my father in law
did rest somky me in my house & then I read
on V.2 of Flavell. I slept after 5 & then went
about worship & was long herein & then went
to my room & read on Durd. on Rev. I went
to my bed after 11.

Nov. 17 Tues. This morning as I went forth to visit family viz. all that I had left, I met with Cameron, Dr. McGour & Dr. Dougall & talked a little with them. I finished my visiting against 8 o'clock. Dr. Keenley informed me of a fire in Glasgow on Thursday last which was beyond the Gallowgate bridge & had burnt several houses. I rested long in Spittall & discoursed with Captain Buchanan & Lady Spittall & Lady Buchaple. I rested long also in the Caffas. Came home near 9 & discoursed with the Taylors. After supper & worship went to bed after 11 & read some on V. 1 of Athen. Oracle.

Nov. 18 Tues. This morning Wm. Govan in M. Portellar & my father in law came to me. Wm. Govan having talkt some time went away after which Walt. Buchanan's wife in Shingles came, to whom I lent 46-13-04 that with 20 ch. lent in Decr. last make up

ls. 13-04 for which I am to have a bond next week. Ja. Dougall & wife also came & cleared
counts of funds for 1716 & proceedings. After
all which my father in law did not come
⁵¹ home. The day being very rainy I kept at home
& wrote some on Song 14. This night my
sister in law Janet Buchanan was with us.

After supper & worship went to bed after 12.
Nov. 19 Wed. This morning I went forth to see
some sick persons & particularly Kath.

McLellan's daughter in Muirhead of Camsoun,
Ja. Boyce's wife in Hole of Arodoch, Jo. Galbraith's
child in Townfoot of Aiber, Ja. Watson's
daughter there, Donald Mc Hutchison's daughter
there, with all these I conversed & prayd.

As also I did visit Jo. Flemings family
in Scrogs & then I rode to the Rosse &
conversed there some time with Drumakill,
Lady & Mr. Parlane. This day William went
to Edinburgh. After I came home I

married Walt. Drummond & Agnes McAdam
& then dined; then was with Jo. Keough &
Ja. Leckie's wife. After that did chat with
my family & read on V. 1 of Athenian Oracle.
After supper & worship went to bed about 12 o'clock
Nov. 20 Th. This morning there came a party
from Bonill to me to be married & brought
a testimoniall with them viz. Wm. McKinlay
& Janet Ewing, the which I did, Mr. Bain
being at the Commission. Then I entered on
the examination of my parish & did
examine Mains, Muirrie, & Gargours. After
which I did marry Jo. McLean & Eliz. Wright.
After that I dined & read on V. 1. of Athen. Oracle.
At night I went in to Walt. Galloway &
did chat with Jo. Morris in Glasgow who also
came into my house a little. After supper
& worship went to bed near to 12 o'clock &
read on the foorsaid book.
Nov. 21 Frid. This day I rode to Dumfries

I examined that town, the Fisheries, Nervie,
& Drunglass. After which I dined in Alexr.
Garners, younger. There were at dinner with us
Janet McFarlane, spouse to Jo. McAdam in
Buchanan. After which I got some money
from him & Alexr. Garner, elder. I came home
about 6 - read on V.1 of Athan. Oracle. After
supper & worship went to bed after 12 o'clock.

⁵⁸ Nov. 22 dat. This morning my father in law
came to me & did breakfast with me at
which Kyne Bark. McLean in Raas came
& gave me some little money. After which
I prepared to go to Dumbarton being to
preach there to-morrow. In my way I payd
Ja. Cunningham in Bent a cow, that is now
with Jo. Mathie, that I had bought from him.
Then I saw Raff. Mc Lelland's daughter in
Kincard, with her I conversed & prayd.
After which I rode to L. Portnellan to pay
Arch. Goran for another cow but he was not

at home. I called at Dr. McAnlay's, Well.
Gowan's, Dr. McKinlay's & enquired about
their welfare. As also at Bellough & crowd
Rob. Ewing some money who promised to pay
me that day month. I called at Mr. Bain's
but he was not come home from the Commission
However I met him betwixt a Levensayde
who informed me they had no very
momentous news before the Commission;
as also that the Parliament sat down the
11 of the month & that there was much
harmony betwixt the King & them. I
arrived at Dumbarton about 5. There came
to me Baylie Blair, Mr. McFarlane ^{alpine} & Mr. Love,
Pby. Clark, who did rest some little time.
I slept after 8 & then prepared for the following
day. After worship went to bed about 12.
Nov. 23 Sab. This morning I endeavoured to
prepare for the work of the day. I went to
Church at 10 & lectured on 1 Pet. 2. 1-7 &

preach both before & afternoon on Col. 3. 11
& had much of divine assistance. After
sermon Mr. Love discouerst with me. I
supt about 6 at which tyme Mr. Mc alpine
& Mr. Love came to me & discouerst with me.
We had all the publick prints for 3 fast
days, the King's Speech to the Parliament
& the address of the Lords & Commons wherein,
which were full of duty & loyalty to his
Majesty promising all encouragement
to carry on the war with Spain. I was
⁵⁹ informed that there was a great struggle
in both Houses of Parliament. It was
carried only by 40 in the House of Lords
& by 60 in the House of Commons. I see
in the prints that there hath been a battle
betwixt the Imperialists & Spaniards at
Melago in Sicily, the Spaniards have lost
about 2000 & the Imperialists 1700 men
& prisoners taken on both sides. The Spaniards

are making all preparations to carry on
the war & have ordered as many as please
to put out privateers & make what prizes
they can of the English. I was informed
also that the old Lady Colgrain dyed
yesterday night at 10 o'clock. Mr. Love sat
with me till after 9. After worship &
reading some of my own wrythen sermons
went to bed after 11.
